



Macdonald Prize, given to the non-fiction work of Canadian history judged to have made the most significant contribution to the understanding of the Canadian past, the prize is sponsored by Manulife Financial in the amount of \$5,000; and the Wallace K. Ferguson Prize, which recognises the outstanding scholarly book in a field of history other than Canadian history.
